

THE GULAG

Objective:

Please research the Soviet Gulag and prepare an interesting and informative slideshow.

Explanation:

Your presentation may focus on any aspect of the Soviet Gulag that interests you– history, living and working conditions, treatment of prisoners, geography, etc. Your slideshow must have a specific focus or subtitle. Research carefully before you begin creating your slideshow. Look for interesting, notable, and unexpected facts and details about Gulags.

Requirements:

The slideshow must include the following:

- 8-10 Slides
- First Slide: Intro slide with Main Title, Subtitle, and Your Name
- Last Slide: Works Consulted slide with all sources consulted

Each slide should contain the following (maximum amounts listed):

- 1-3 Images
- 3-5 Factual Bullet Points (no more than 8 words / point)
- If possible, include notes / explanations for each slide (use 'slide notes' feature)

Do not 'cut and paste' phrases or sentences from the internet onto your slides or intro your notes. If your slideshow shows evidence of copy and pasting, you will lose all credit for this assignment. All text must be generated and input independent of the internet. One effective way to make sure you are not taking the phrases of others, shut the website down before you begin typing your bullet points.

You may be selected randomly to present your slideshow in the future.

Deadline:

This project is designed to help you work under a tight timeframe. Slideshow is due by the end of class *today*. No credit will be issued for late submissions. If you don't finish, it is to your advantage to submit a partially finished slideshow.

Grading: Slideshows will be evaluated based on attention to detail, level to which slideshow fulfills requirements, and ability of slideshow to convey interesting and important details.

Point Value: 20 points
